BOARD MEETING MINUTES - NOVEMBER 10, 2020

Meeting called to order at 6:00pm with all in attendance.

Minutes of the previous meeting were accepted as read, with Cindy Arquette and Jody Hunt making the motions. Motion carried

Treasurer's report was accepted as presented, with motions made by Jean Farmer and Alice Trumble. Motion carried.

Our library statistics show a steady increase in circulation and patron visits. We have loaned 233 books to other libraries with our patrons borrowing 17 from inter loan. Baby steps, but, it's getting a little better. Wishing for better things in the new year.

It was decided to do the Silent Auction for a bit longer; opening bids the week before Christmas instead of Thanksgiving. We will try to put more on social media and let people know what we have.

Director Bev Ripka continues to do the Director and JAB meetings by Zoom monthly. Several monthly meetings on the new state minimum standards for libraries are ongoing with the next one 12/2.

Covid had a huge impact on several things this year. The Williamstown Library was no exception. We were unable to hold our Summer Reading Program, June Fundraiser, Volunteer Dinner and our Christmas Tea. Plans are already being made for the new year, in hopes that we can hold these events in 2021.

We feel very fortunate we will receive money from Oswego County and our town board sent us \$1000. There is no meeting held in the month of December with our budget meeting/director evaluation being scheduled for January 12th.

Meeting adjourned at 6:30pm, with Jody Hunt and Jean Farmer making the motions. Motion carried. Next meeting January 12, 2021 in the Community Room at 6:00pm.
