BOARD MEETING MINUTES - SEPTEMBER 8, 2020

Meeting called to order at 6:15pm, with all in attendance, with the exception of Jody Hunt.

Minutes of the previous meeting were accepted as read, with motions to accept being made by Cindy Arquette and Cherie Tietjen. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report was accepted as presented, with motions made by Jean Farmer and Alice Trumble. Motion carried.

Library statistics show our library is still being used in many different ways. We have loaned a total of 591 books to other libraries in the last 3 months. We have added 6 new patrons. Overdrive shows that 82 e-books and 120 e-audios have been downloaded in the last three months by our patrons.

Director Bev Ripka will be in touch with our school (APW) librarian to see if we can co-ordinate with them to help with need of books for students. We have a mixed learning ways this fall including homeschooling, in person and online (virtual) from home.

To have enough PPE available in our library has so far, cost us \$955.40. We are required to have a month's supply on hand.

The Oswego County Library Council meeting is supposed to be held next month at Williamstown. We will see.

It was decided to hold another Silent Auction this fall. Things can be spread out in the community room for the bidders to view. Not having the BIG sale this year, it was thought that this might give our patrons a reason to stop in and see that we are trying to get back to business.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:15pm with Cindy Arquette and Sue Billington making the motions. Motion carried.
