Board Minutes
November 9, 2021

Meeting called to order at 6:15pm with all in attendance with the exception of Jean Farmer and Jody Hunt, who were excused at this time.

Minutes of previous meeting were accepted as read with Cindy Arquette and Sue Billington making the motions. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report was accepted a presented with Alice Trumble and Cherie Tietjen making the motions. Motion carried.

A resolution was agreed upon to be placed on the APW school budget in the spring with a vote of :

Library statistics show that our attendance is holding steady during the fall months. Overdrive is still an important part of our Library service along with internet service. We have loaned out 162 titles to other libraries and our patrons have borrowed 99 through interlibrary loans. We are still providing services to our patrons.

It was decided not to have a Silent Auction this fall like we did last year, and will instead, do one in the mid- winter months.

Our Christmas Tea will once again be cancelled. We are hoping to continue this next year. Thoughts of possibly holding a "Summertime Concert" with local talent in place of the Tea.

Supplies for SRP have been ordered. The theme for 2022 is Oceans and sea life.

Beginning January 2023, trustees will be required to take at least 2 hours of training per year. NCLS offers these sessions often during the year. It can be done on an individual basis.

Meeting adjourned at 7:05pm, with Sue Billington and Cindy Arquette making the motions. Motion carried. Next meeting, January 11, 2022 at 6:30 pm in the Community Room. This will be a Budget meeting.
